

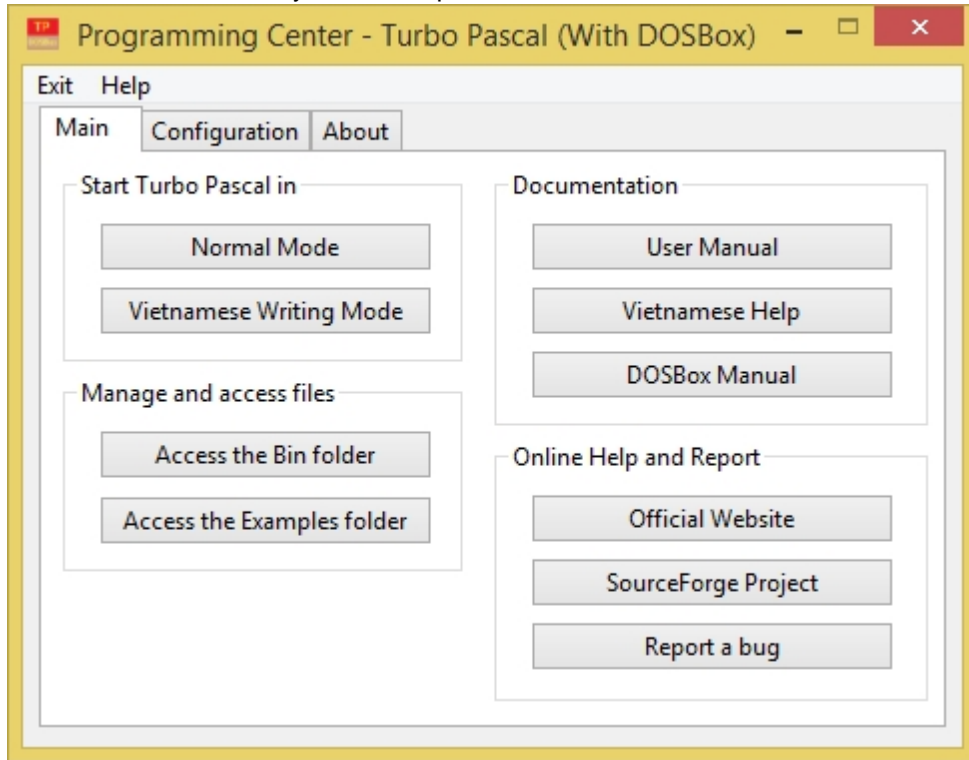

Introduction

Programming center of Turbo Pascal (With DOSBox). This is where you can access Turbo Pascal running modes, Pascal files stored in memory, see examples of Pascal, access related documents.



Main Tab

The main tab contains a number of functions that allow you to run Turbo Pascal, access files and help. The functions contained in this Tab are:

Functions	Description
Start Turbo Pascal	
Normal Mode	Turbo Pascal (With DOSBox) has 2 running modes: Normal mode and Vietnamese writing 'mode'. The Vietnamese writing mode is only a little different from the normal mode 'which is more integrated with Vietnamese Input Support Kit to be able to write Vietnamese in Turbo Pascal. If you use TCVN library to write Vietnamese language, you do not need to use Vietnamese writing mode.
Vietnamese Writing Mode	
Manage and access files	
Access the Bin folder	Access to the directory containing most of pascal files you have saved. You can also copy the pascal file into it to program in Turbo Pascal. Note that you need to restart Turbo Pascal to open the copied file
Access the Examples folder	Access examples of Turbo Pascal
Documentation and Online Help	
Access help, documentation related to DOSBox and Turbo Pascal, view website and report software bugs.	

Configuration and About Tab

Configuration tab

This tab allows you to configure DOSBox options

Click the buttons on this tab to access and configure DOSBox .conf files in run mode. Each mode has its own DOSBox configuration file. Note that accessing and modifying these files requires knowledge of DOSBox settings and may change how DOSBox works. This tab shows you the information related to Turbo Pascal (With DOSBox)
